Foxhole Learning Academy Breakfast Club – September 2023

The Breakfast Club provides quality wrap around care for pupils at Foxhole Learning Academy. The Aims of the Club are to:

- support families by providing before school childcare from 8.00 am until 8.35am
- provide a selection of creative and play based activities
- offer the children breakfast each morning in a safe and friendly environment
- offer a healthy breakfast and drink to all pupils arriving between 8:00 and 8:20am

Allocated Places

The school environment and the minimum child ratios meets the requirements of DfE guidelines.

The Breakfast club is accommodated in the school.

Our Breakfast Club is unable to provide one-to-one support for individual children without prior planning for this. If your child has additional needs and would like to access the provision, please speak with our SENDCo.

The Breakfast Club will run from 8.00am until 8.45am from Monday to Friday during term time. The Breakfast Club will be closed during school holidays and for 5 days each year to provide staff training and development (INSET days)

The school reserves the right to make changes to the days and times offered due to unforeseen circumstances such as acts of nature.

Places

Places are to be booked via the MyEd app in advance and will be offered on a first come, first served basis. Places can be booked up until the day before the place is needed.

Charges

The charges from September 2023 per session are as follows:
Breakfast Club - £1.50 per child per session, there is no charge for children who are eligible for Free School Meals.

Payment must be paid in advance when booking.





Payment is required via MyEd when booking your session (our online payment system).

In line with school and trust policies, the school reserves the right to withdraw a child's place if accounts are not kept up to date.

If you no longer need a place

Please let us know with as much notice as possible so we can offer the place to another child.
